Earthquake Drill at NRP

On May 5th NRP will be holding a large scale earthquake drill. Do not be alarmed. The school regularly practices all types of emergencies, from fire drills to a school lock down. The Earthquake Drill will commence at 2pm. To make it more realistic, parents have the option to participate in the student release portion of the drill. We are to meet outside on the gravel field after 2pm (this will give the school time to run their portion uninterrupted). Please do not go into the school as this will cause more work for the staff.

Once all the students are safely outside parents can go stand behind their child's division and await instructions from the teacher. Again, please do not go straight to your child. This practice is an attempt to make it as realistic as possible.

If you are unable to come please do not worry. All children not picked up early will simply return to their classroom as normal and await regular dismissal.
