Motion to approve the minutes from the PAC AGM on October 4,2016. All in favor, motion passed.

1. PAC Chair Report/Finance Report/Committee Report combined:

- Jody announced that NRP has exceeded its Direct Appeal goal (\$25,000) by \$1400 (\$1300 plus the check for \$100 Jody found today).
- Jody confirmed that application for the Gaming grant had not been made back in April; a
 late application is in the works but we are no longer guaranteed for the \$15,000 that
 was budgeted and earmarked for computers and iPads.
- General Account standing: \$89,733, less what we owe for catering, plus the direct appeal brings us to roughly \$40k.
- The lunch program so far (September November) has netted \$5900.
- The January March menus will be available shortly.
- A request has been made by the school for PAC consideration: \$2000 to build the foundation of a really great, sustainable pottery program (glazes, and other supplies).
 Trevor has researched but there's only 1 supplier in BC for what they need.

Motion: Beth Krisciunas moved that the extra Direct Appeal money, plus a top up for a total of \$2000 be allocated to the school for the pottery studio. Wendy Yip seconded. All in favor, motion passed.

2. School Report: Introduce Trevor Wrinch

Trevor Wrinch introduced himself as a new teacher in the Sasamat-Khatsahlano Grade 7/8 Pod. He previously taught for 10 years in East Vancouver, and in countries like Taiwan, China and Japan. He fell in love with NRP when he came for a visit in 2015. He loved the student engagement and community projects, so when a middle school teaching position was posted, he applied. Trevor's interests include coaching sports, sponsoring programming and 3D art clubs, and creating meaningful learning activities for students. Tevor also mention that there were not enough sign-ups for senior boy's volleyball this term.
