Orange Shirt Day is a legacy of the St. Joseph Mission (SJM) residential school commemoration event held in Williams Lake, BC in May 2013. It grew out of Phyllis Webstad's story of having her shiny new orange shirt taken away on her first day of school at the Mission, and it has become an opportunity to keep the discussion on all aspects of residential schools happening annually.

With so many parents and so many students, our PAC works very hard at communication. We are really trying to make things easy this year. The main tools we will use are the PAC email and the "NEW" PAC Website. We are requesting that all parents go to the website and "follow"us. Once you do you will receive an email notification every time we post. You will also then be added to the PAC email list. Why? The most

basic reason would be in case of an emergency. If something unforeseen happens then the school will post out on the NRP App. The PAC Chair will then forward the information onto our website. You will receive a notification via your email. If possible the PAC Chair will forward the information by email but access to all the contacts may not be possible.



#### **Parent/Teacher Conference:**

Also called Goal Setting Conference, where parents get to sit with your child and the teacher to discuss goals for the upcoming term. This term, the conferences will take place on Oct. 25 and Oct. 26. Please remember to pick up your child at 2:00pm on both days. You will get a note from the teacher in advance to choose a couple of time slots that suit your schedule. Later, the teacher will confirm the conference time with you.



# Parking:

At NRP, there are two accessible parking spots in the visitor parking lot, they are specifically for those with permits to use. Unless you have a government issued sticker, please do not take the spots or block the access path to the parking spots. Even it is just for a few minutes, it is still illegal and will cause a lot of hassles to the ones who really need it.

#### **All About School**

**Supervision Aides** - NRP has five supervision aides to ensure safety and security of students while they are at play on school playgrounds. They are paid part-time employees hired by VSB. Three of them are assigned to supervise the primary side, and two are in charge of the middle school side during morning recess and lunch time.

Kindergarteners are asked to wear a pinning vest (red, yellow and blue) while they are out playing on the playground, so they are easily spotted by other students and adults. If a child is injured, he/she should report to the supervision aides and 1-2 friends will escort him/her into the office. If the injure is severe enough, the supervision aides will radio into the office, and parents will be contacted.
