School Report:

Karen Reporting:

Staffing Changes

- Along with Karen moving to Norquay and Teena Smith coming there have been some changes with staffing
 - Maple: Sian Dowle has been hired as Learning Support
 - Alder: Betty Mang is on Mat Leave and just had a baby boy today. Congrats to her!! Becky is filling Betty's mat leave
 - Cedar: Angela Hicks still off Ms. McConville was filling in but now Natalie Anderson is covering during Angela's absence.
 - Hemlock: Robin Robertson has left and Steven Asdrubale has been hired to replace him as Learning Support

Inquiry Learning:

- It is not only NRP students who are doing Inquiry learning! NRP staff is also hard at work in this area.
- The VSB has a program called "Collaborative Inquiry". Currently NRP has teachers participating in 6 groups doing 6 different Inquiry projects as well as 3 sets of teachers in District Based Inquiry projects.
- A very exciting time and it is great for parents to know that our teachers are constantly expanding their learning.

Communicating Student Learning (CSL):

- The title "Report Card" is now replaced by CSL. It provides better ongoing feedback for students
- NRP has been involved in the Pilot Project for CSL for the past 3 years..
- What and When can parents expect CSL to happen?
 - Goal Setting Conferences: Just happened several weeks ago
 - o Paper Report Cards: End of January and end of June
 - o Student Led Conference: March
 - Each Community will generally hold a Celebration of Learning several times during the school year. This is dependent on the Community so parents should keep an eye out for communication.
- Remember that NRP Reporting does not use letter grades. Half of all VSB schools are now following this model.
 - Important to note that mini schools are aware of this and that report cards do not get handed out until the end of January. They will accommodate any and all students applying to mini schools.
 - This also applies to high schools. NRP is in constant communication with UHill Secondary about the students that are moving there next September. In fact staff and administration from both NRP and UHill Secondary have already met and gone over each child that will be attending high school next year.
- About ½ of the VSB district is currently involved in the CSL Pilot project.
 It was estimated that by Sept. 2019 all schools would be using this
 model but the Province of BC is actually looking at wanting to roll this
 out province wide. So now the district will wait on the Ministry of
 Education for their plan.
- Transitioning to UHill Secondary:
 - Staff and administration from both schools will continue their close collaboration to make the student transition as smooth as possible.
 - Also coming up in the next few months:
 - Parent Info Night
 - The UHill Counsellor coming to NRP to speak to students
 - Kids from NRP will visit the high school.

New Business:

Grade 8 student organizing Santa Workshop for Fri. Dec. 14
 Let us all support this fundraiser! Bring in one or more items (Gently used book, toy or game). Items will be sold on Dec. 14th. Free Gift Wrapping available!

- <u>Food Bank:</u> The Grade 8 Leadership team is taking the lead on this. Food bank donation boxes will be passed around to all classes this week. Please bring a non perishable food item to donate!
 - NRP will donate half of what is raised to the UBC Food Bank (used by students and families on campus) and half to the Greater Vancouver Food Bank.
 - Jody will send messaging out before the end of the week along with a suggested list of debatable items.
