## 3. NRP STAFF REPORT: Principal Henry Peters & Vice Principal Charmaine Ho

- The world can feel unhopeful, but it's important to raise hopeful kids. Focus on creating curiosity. NRP
  fosters curiosity, as it primes children's brains for learning. Hope is sometimes a matter of noticing the
  good things that are happening. Allow students to build their own worlds under your watchful eye, but
  not under your thumb.
- Staffing: NRP will have the same number of divisions again next year, including five kindergarten classes. At some point, year seven won't fit in the building. We have 12 open spots in the whole school for next year. Hiring teachers now.
- School fees for 2025-26: \$35 school fee is same. Not asking for a performance fee or activity fee up
  front for next year, but will ask for those when they are needed; those fees will be optional, as they are
  considered supplementary. Administrators rely on the PAC to subsidize some of the supplementary
  things
- Charmaine Ho is the new vice principal for next year, replacing Julia Clark
