## Hot Lunch Program

The Hot Lunch Program is a fundraiser. While maintaining food costs as low as we can, we make about 10% on each food item. All that money goes back to support children's needs at the school! This program is also essential to help ease the burden of lunch preparation for caregivers.

## Field Trip Funds

PAC applies the Gaming Grant towards \$20/student to supplement field trips. All divisions are eligible to access these funds. Trips this year included a visit to Grouse Mountain, skating, museum visits, Science World and more!

## Grade 7 Graduation

The Grade 7 Grad Committee arranges a celebration for the graduating class, including a dance, special hoodies and various activities to create long-lasting memories.

## Yearbook

Volunteers work tirelessly to photograph happenings at the school and create a keepsake yearbook for families to purchase.

## Advocacy

PAC is the officially recognized collective voice of parents of their school. A PAC, through its elected officers, may advise the school board, the principal and staff of the school respecting any matter relating to the education of the students and the school.

## Creating Community

PAC-run events help foster a strong sense of community within the school. Throughout the year, these events provide opportunities for students, families, and staff to connect, engage, and build relationships.

# HOW WE SUPPORT TEACHERS

We are fortunate enough to have amazing administration, teachers, support staff and office staff.

PAC supports the school in many ways.

## **Classroom, Specialized Support Assistant, and Learning Support Teacher Funds**

Each teacher, SSA and LST are provided with a set amount of funds for purchases for their classroom each year.

These purchases included curriculum packages, basic classroom supplies like plasticine, white boards, paint, etc, noise canceling headphones, seeds, puzzles, boardgames, books, classroom furniture and more.

Funds were also used to bring in experts to enhance classroom learning.

## **Teacher/Staff Appreciation**

PAC hosts two delicious luncheons each year to thank teachers and staff for their efforts. Staff gathers in the Multipurpose Room for a hot meal and social time.

## **Specialist Funds**

Library, music, foods and counselling receive funds to assist their programs in running.

This included restocking books at the library for new titles and to replace damaged books, the purchase of choral risers to support the music program, books and supplies to support the school counselor, and supplementing the food and equipment costs for the foods class.

## **Clubs and Sports Equipment**

Funds provided t-shirts for dance club, supplies to improve the gardens in A-Wing including adding an irrigation system, a new speaker to support school performances, and sports equipment for students to use at recess.
